RESULTS OF THE FEBRUARY 2013 AUCTION FOR FIRSTENERGY'S PENNSYLVANIA DEFAULT SERVICE PROGRAM

CRA International, Inc. d/b/a Charles River Associates (“CRA”) conducted the Default Service solicitation on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company. The Residential/Commercial (Fixed Price) Auction was conducted on February 12, 2013.

Through this auction process, the Companies sought to procure full requirements Default Supply generation service for their Default Service Customers for the period June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014.

On February 14, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, via a Secretarial Letter, announced that it accepted the results of the Residential/Commercial (Fixed Price) Auction. Results are summarized below.
