RESULTS OF THE OCTOBER 2018 AUCTION FOR FIRSTENERGY'S PENNSYLVANIA DSP-IV DEFAULT SERVICE PROGRAM

As the Independent Evaluator, CRA International, Inc. d/b/a Charles River Associates ("CRA") completed the Default Service solicitation on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company ("Companies"). The DSP-IV Commercial (Fixed Price) Auction was conducted on October 29, 2018.

Through this auction process for their Default Service Program DSP-IV, the Companies sought to procure full requirements Default Supply generation service for their Default Service Customers for the period December 2018 through February 2019.

On October 31, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, via a Secretarial Letter, announced that it accepted the results of the auction. The results are summarized in the table below.
